## 5-oz. Commercial Weed Barrier

**Our 5-oz. Commercial Weed Barrier is made of polypropylene with a polyester blend and can be cut to size using household scissors.**

Before installing Commercial Weed Barrier remove all pre-existing grasses and weeds. If there are areas where difficult, hardy, or invasive perennials exist, such as nutsedge, quackgrass, Bermuda grass, etc., be sure to fully remove or kill the weeds before installation. For placement in areas where there will be no live plants, such as a rock garden, we suggest using a soil sterilant prior to installation. When using organic mulch as a covering, using a pre-emergence herbicide will prevent weed seeds from growing on top of the fabric.

Large plants should be planted before fabric placement, while plants smaller than 1 gallon may be planted after installation. When possible, minimize soil buildup on top of the fabric to prevent weeds from germinating on the fabric.

The weed barrier should be installed smooth side up and can be placed over existing plants by cutting an X shape into the fabric for the plants to fit through. It is okay for the fabric to lay against the stems of the plants. After being properly installed, the Commercial Weed Barrier can then be covered by stone or mulch. If possible, use plenty of stone/mulch to cover the fabric. Preventing direct exposure to sunlight will help to increase its longevity.

Thanks to Commercial Weed Barrier's breathable design, the application of water, fertilizers, or insecticides can be done over the top of the fabric, and they will filter through to the soil without damaging or degrading the fabric itself.
